At this meeting, the future of MPCMA will be discussed and 9 plans for education will be discussed. 10 11 The MPCMA President has been approached by the LBMA President regarding the possible dissolution of the LB Chapter. It was discussed that the LB members would have the option to 12 join MPCMA or both MP and LB Chapters could combine to form a new larger Chapter. After 13 discussing these options with the MPCMA board members, all members agreed that the best 14 option would be to dissolve both Chapters and form a new Chapter that would cover the entire 15 Marion-Polk-Linn-Benton counties. This would allow for a larger membership, greater 16 17 attendance at educational events, a local medical assisting program for training new medical assistants, increase in student memberships and a larger pool of leaders. This option has been 18 discussed with OSMA President Candy Miller, CMA (AAMA). She has outlined the process 19 for reaching these goals; however, no action has been taken at this time. This will be discussed 20 at the MPCMA board meeting on 3/11/21. After that time, a joint board meeting will be 21 planned for both MP and LB leaders to discuss plans for moving forward with this option.
